### Registration's Secretary's Report

The Registration Secretary confirmed that 1,505 Players had been registered with the League to date.

Following a number of issues, Clubs are reminded that they are responsible for dealing with all discipline with the respective County Football Associations, and ensure they are up-to-date with players who are suspended.

### Match Based Suspensions:

When players are sent-off during a match, a reminder that with match based suspensions, the player's suspension will commence 14 days after that match, and the correct number of matches will have to be served. If you have not received any paperwork it is the responsibility of the Clubs to contact their respective County Football Association to ensure the correct numbers of matches are served. The Match Report Form has now been updated to incorporate this.

### Match Day Player Registrations:

The Registration Secretary also wishes to remind all Clubs to ensure that the registration forms are signed by an Official of the Club prior to submitting. This signature should be a Club Officer as stated in the League Rules. Under F.A. Protocol, Club Officers are: Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer. Team Managers are not Club Officers.

The space for the counter-signature is only for registrations completed on the match day. This counter-signature should be that of an opposing team Official (as noted above).

### Registration Verifications:

Match Day Player Registration Verifications have now commenced, with one Club being caught out at this stage, who will be written to asking for their observations prior to any formal charging.

### Match Report Sheets:

This would be trialled and subject to working and streamlining the process, a formal position would be incorporated into the League Rules for the 2016 - 2017 Season. Both Nick Aldren and Neil Holman advised this was working well so far this season.

### Referee's Secretary's Report

The Referee's Secretary did not have any issues to highlight.

The Management Committee would be grateful if Club's manage to find a Referee / Stand-In Official where one has not been appointed, they could notify the Referee's Secretary accordingly to avoid the possibility of two Official's turning up at the same match.

Match Official's to be reminded to contact Club's by telephone if they have to pull out on a Saturday morning to ensure that Club's receive the message, in the same way as Club's are reminded to contact Match Official's by telephone in matches are cancelled for any reason.

### Fixture's Secretary's Report:

The Fixture's Secretary advised that the next set of fixtures had been issued and she was continuing to try and maximise the number of matches each week so that Clubs were playing regular football.

The Fixture's Secretary advised that the Reserve Cup Competition had now started to be scheduled within the fixtures.

The Fixtures Secretary noted she had been required to change the fixtures for Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2016 as Clean Slate had progressed through to the next round of the National Christian Trophy which is a National Competition.

## Postponements / Free Weekends

Clubs are reminded that if they require a free weekend for any reason, they are to contact the League Fixtures Secretary a minimum of 5 weeks before the requested date. Once fixtures are published, the League Rules do not permit fixtures to be either postponed or put back.

## Abandoned Fixture - Brackley Old Boys F.C. Vs Brackley Sports F.C. (Interdivisional Trophy):

The Management Committee have reviewed all information submitted in respect of the cancelled fixture on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> December 2015 and find as follows:

The decision of the Leisure Centre to cancel all fixtures on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> December 2015 was taken under duress of a member of Brackley Sports F.C. attending the Centre very early on the morning of the match. However shortly afterwards, another team turned up and that match was deemed playable by the match referee, and took place.

The Leisure Centre acknowledges that they didn't contact Brackley Old Boys F.C. to advise them that the ground was thought to be unplayable, and were only aware of the decision as a result of a posting on Social Media.

The Secretary of Brackley Old Boys F.C. attended the Leisure Centre later on the morning of the match, and noting that a game was already taking place, queried how such a decision could have been taken.

The match referee for the Brackley Old Boys F.C. Vs Brackley Sports F.C. fixture attended the ground at 12.20pm and also deemed the ground playable.

Following lengthy discussion, and based on the information received, it was the decision of the Management Committee that the fixture should not have been cancelled, and that decision was only taken as a result of influence by Brackley Sports F.C., the opposition team in the fixture, attending the ground on the morning of the match, purporting to be representing both teams.

It was further the decision of the Management Committee that Brackley Sports F.C. would be expelled from the Interdivisional Trophy and the Match Awarded to Brackley Old Boys F.C.

Brackley Sports F.C. are to be fined the sum of £ 50.00 for failing to fulfil the fixture and also to reimburse the League the sum of £35.00 being the Match Official's fee paid on the day of the fixture - **Total Charge £ 85.00.**

## Any Other Business:

### Social Media:

Clubs are reminded that any posts on Social Media (e.g. Twitter, Facebook, Websites) should not relate to other teams, officials etc.... The Football Association takes such posts very seriously and can result in charges being raised against Individuals and / or Clubs. All Clubs have a responsibility to ensure that any such media items are monitored.

Should any Club have any concerns over what is being posted on social media, they can contact the League or go directly to their respective County F.A.

## Respect

The League reminds all Clubs and Officials of the FA Respect Programme, and that the North Bucks & District Football League is a designated Respect League. All parties are to ensure that the Respect Programme is followed at all times, in particular the pre-match handshake.

**Awards:**

The Treasurer noted she would arrange for brochures for awards to be collected for the next meeting.

**Meeting Dates:**

The Chairman advised that following communication with Neil Holman, Thursday evenings were a problem for the meeting and obviously he wanted to attend. The Committee agreed that the meetings would be changed from a Thursday night to a Tuesday night effective end of January 2016 and reflected under dates for future meetings below.

**Berks & Bucks F.A. Initiative:**

Mr. Aldren advised that the Berks & Bucks F.A. were currently running an 11 v 11 football initiative during January 2016 to try and support Clubs and reduce the numbers of teams that are being lost.

Mr. Aldren and Mr. McStraw put forward the issue of running Women's football within the North Bucks & District Football League. The Chairman requested that all Committee Members give this some thought to be discussed at the next meeting.

**Committee Jackets:**

Reference previous minutes, the Treasurer had obtained some information regarding wet-weather jackets for members of the Committee. Following discussion, a sample would be arranged (hopefully) for the next meeting to be reviewed and / or approved by the Committee.

**Syresham F.C.:**

Mr. Aldren raised the issue of Syresham F.C. and their recently cancelled fixture and whether as a League we should meet with the Club to try and assist to avoid this happening in future.

As Secretary of Syresham F.C., the Chairman noted that whilst this offer was very kind, unless the League are able to recruit a few more players for them or stop the Club's players from getting injured and / or working weekends, there would probably not be much benefit in meeting. This response was noted and agreed a meeting would not be worthwhile.

Clubs MUST reply to each charge with one of the above options, not later than 7 days from issue of this notification. Failure to respond by this date will result in an additional charge for failing to deal with the business of the League in accordance with Rule 5 (H). Should you be in any doubt please contact the League.

**Rule 5 (H) Failing to Satisfactorily Attend to the Business and / or Correspondence of the League**

Silverstone F.C. Repeatedly failing to respond to the League's requests for submission of their Match Report Sheet from Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2015.

**Rule 8 (J) (ii) Players Charged with Misconduct for Registration Irregularities**

The Leisure Centre acknowledges that they didn't contact Brackley Old Boys F.C. to advise them that the ground was thought to be unplayable, and were only aware of the decision as a result of a posting on Social Media.

The Secretary of Brackley Old Boys F.C. attended the Leisure Centre later on the morning of the match, and noting that a game was already taking place, queried how such a decision could have been taken.

The match referee for the Brackley Old Boys F.C. Vs Brackley Sports F.C. fixture attended the ground at 12.20pm and also deemed the ground playable.

Following lengthy discussion, and based on the information received, it was the decision of the Management Committee that the fixture should not have been cancelled, and that decision was only taken as a result of influence by Brackley Sports F.C., the opposition team in the fixture, attending the ground on the morning of the match, purporting to be representing both teams.

It was further the decision of the Management Committee that Brackley Sports F.C. would be expelled from the Interdivisional Trophy and the Match Awarded to Brackley Old Boys F.C.
