Minutes of the League Management Meeting

Chairman's Opening Address:

The Chairman duly welcomed all members to the meeting.

Committee Issues:

The Chairman highlighted that a number of issues within the Committee had come to a head over the past few weeks and these needed to be resolved if the League Management Committee was to continue to function effectively to provide a service to Member Clubs.

The Chairman advised all Committee Members that the function of the Committee was to work together to provide and administer a grass roots football league, all with the same intentions of being fair, consistent, and applying the Rules of the League as required and within their context. As a Committee, there will be occasions where there is a disagreement in a decision, but every decision made should be within the intentions set out above.

The Chairman advised that Mr. Hodges had sent in his resignation following a decision made at the last meeting. It was agreed at the meeting that the Chairman would write back to Mr. Hodges asking him to reconsider his resignation.

The Management Committee reviewed a series of correspondence from various Members of the Committee and spent a considerable amount of time trying to get to the bottom of the causes of frustration and conflict within the Committee and resolving these issues in order to move forward, providing football for our Member Clubs.

The Management Committee felt that positive discussions on all points raised had taken place.

Registration's Secretary's Report

The Registration Secretary was not present at the meeting, however had forwarded a few items for discussion as follows:

Final Total of Players Registered with the League for the 2015 / 2016 Season - 1601

Marsh Gibbon F.C. Marsh Gibbon F.C. had submitted a registration form for a player aged 15, who would not be 16 until the end of March 2016. The Management Committee agreed to permit the registration since it had been submitted prior to the deadline of 1st March 2016.

Twyford United F.C. Query highlighted regarding Player Registration for MK Gallactico, Playing also for Winslow United in the South Midlands League.

Post Meeting Note: The Chairman had looked into this query, and under the Rules of the League, Players who play at a higher level, provided it is beneath the Premier Division of the South Midlands League are permitted to play within the Premier Division to Division One Inclusive in the North Bucks & District Football League.

Winslow United F.C. play in Division One of the South Midlands League and therefore the player is entitled to play in the North Bucks & District Football League - Intermediate Division without any special permission being required, however would not be permitted to play in Division Two.

Match Based Suspensions:

When players are sent-off during a match, a reminder that with match based suspensions, the player's suspension will commence 14 days after that match, and the correct number of matches will have to be served. If you have not received any paperwork it is the responsibility of the Clubs to contact their respective County Football Association to ensure the correct numbers of matches are served. The Match Report Form has now been updated to incorporate this.

This would be trialled and subject to working and streamlining the process, a formal position would be incorporated into the League Rules for the 2016 - 2017 Season. Both Nick Aldren and Neil Holman advised this was working well so far this season.

Referee's Secretary's Report

The Referee's Secretary did not have any issues to highlight. A couple of new Match Officials had been added to the League Panel.

Fixture's Secretary's Report:

The Fixture's Secretary advised that the next set of fixtures had been issued and she was continuing to try and maximise the number of matches each week so that Clubs were playing regular football.

The Fixture's Secretary noted that she also had to re-arrange a number of fixtures as a result of Cup matches being carried over through weather disruption.

Postponements / Free Weekends

Clubs are reminded that if they require a free weekend for any reason, they are to contact the League Fixtures Secretary a minimum of 5 weeks before the requested date. Once fixtures are published, the League Rules do not permit fixtures to be either postponed or put back.

Social Media:

Clubs are reminded that any posts on Social Media (e.g. Twitter, Facebook, Websites) should not relate to other teams, officials etc.... The Football Association takes such posts very seriously and can result in charges being raised against Individuals and / or Clubs. All Clubs have a responsibility to ensure that any such media items are monitored.

Should any Club have any concerns over what is being posted on social media, they can contact the League or go directly to their respective County F.A.

Respect

The League reminds all Clubs and Officials of the FA Respect Programme, and that the North Bucks & District Football League is a designated Respect League. All parties are to ensure that the Respect Programme is followed at all times, in particular the pre-match handshake. A reminder to be sent to all Match Officials to ensure this is carried out.

Final Venues

It was agreed that the League's finals would be held at Buckingham Athletic Football Club as in previous seasons and Mr. Holman would contact Tony Checkley at the club to try and arrange some dates.

Specific finals will be allocated to the above dates once semi-finals have been played and in line with how far League fixtures have progressed in each division to avoid Clubs waiting without matches to play a final.

Final Programmes

The Chairman had agreed once again to compile and print the programmes for the finals. Mr. Aldren offered to assist and would collate the various details from Clubs who progress to the finals to support the Chairman in preparing these. The Chairman would forward a template e-mail for Mr. Aldren to obtain this information.

Reserve Team Challenge Trophy

The League has reintroduced the Reserve Team Challenge Trophy this season however will need to present a trophy at the final. The Chairman had a number of old cups passed to him from the previous Secretary and would look to see if this trophy was one of the Cups in his possession, if not, one would have to be purchased.

The previous Reserve Team Trophy was not one in the possession of the Chairman and it was agreed that a new Cup would be purchased. It was agreed that the Cup would be named in memory of the former league General Secretary, Mr. B.J. Ward, and the treasurer would consult with the family prior to ordering.

It was agreed that the cup would be named "The B.J. Ward Memorial Cup" for "The North Bucks & District Football League - Reserve Team Challenge Trophy".

Club Insurance

On behalf of the Berks & Bucks County Football Association, a reminder that the minimum insurance cover required for affiliation is only a basic minimum package in relation to Personal Accident cover, and it would be worth all Clubs reviewing the small print in the terms and conditions of the cover to ensure that this cover is suitable for their Club (as it may be in addition to another Policy) and include such items as Player to Player cover etc...

League Development Plan

The Chairman gave an overview of what was required in respect of the League Development Plan and expressed that this item of work would require the full support of the Management Committee in sharing the workload. The Chairman would circulate to the Management Committee a series of information that needed to be covered and some guidance.

In addition, this would be circulated to Member Clubs to have their input on the future shape of the League.

Following a Match Day Registration Verification carried out by the League, and review of Player Registration Forms for this season and last season, it is apparent that the Club have falsified the Player Registration Form for this season in contravention of the procedures laid down under Rule 8 for Player Registrations.
